Dear Parents and Carers,

  - Are currently receiving services from Child Safety, including children who are subject to a child protection order.
  - Subject to a youth justice order.
- Children in designated indigenous communities.

Finally, to all of our students, in particular our graduating students, please have wonderful Easter break and we look forward to term 2 being productive. The government, Education Queensland and schools will continue to work closely together so that you will not be disadvantaged during this time. Our part is to provide the support and the necessary resources and your part is to continue to put in the time and the effort to succeed.
