



Eagleby Learning Centre (ELC) was opened over 25 years ago with a focus on various short courses for the local community for both school aged students and adults. ELC is the SERLC's biggest and most established campus.


Fourteen years ago, the model was significantly changed to meet the growing need of disenfranchised youth in the community. ELC now aligns with State Secondary Education and has grown rapidly ever since.

ELC has 6 classrooms, 1 construction and 1 engineering workshop. The campus also has outdoor learning rooms. The campus is **not** a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) with all computers supplied in the classroom by the campus.

Helensvale Learning Centre

Helensvale Learning Centre (HLC) is the third campus of the SERLC and has come about due to the success of the other two campuses and the growing need for an alternative avenue for students to obtain their year 10 and Queensland Certificate of Education in the State Education system.

HLC has 6 big classrooms The campus is **not** a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) with all computers supplied in the classroom by the campus.

The Helensvale campus offers the Northern Gold Coast region the opportunity of an alternative State High Education. HLC is a campus of the SERLC so it is eligible for mature aged students.

To access reception, you must walk down the right side of the building to the 2nd last door and the entrance to reception will be there.

The Varsity Lakes Learning Centre (VLC) was opened in July 2015 and is the second campus of the SERLC to be opened. It is modelled on ELC and was established due to the increasing demand for an school experience for students on the Gold Coast. It has experienced rapid growth during this time.

VLC has 6 big classrooms The campus is **not** a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) with all computers supplied in the classroom by the campus.

The campus offers a full range of subjects for year 10 through to year 12. VLC is a campus of the SERLC so it is eligible for mature aged students.



UniStart + 1 certificate III + units in Essential English and Maths

UNISTART - UniStart builds confidence in Year 12 students and equips them with the skills required for university study. Year 12 students who successfully complete UniStart for Schools and who successfully complete Year 12, are guaranteed entry into a Southern Cross University undergraduate course.

Additionally they can use this course + a certificate III to apply to QTAC for other Universities.

Step 1

Complete the enrolment forms. 2025 general enrolment application.

Step 2

Contact the campus your student wishes to attend to arrange a convenient interview time. Enrolment enquiries and appointments must be made through the campus Admin Officer:

Due to enrolment capacity and growth, SERLC encourages enrolment of students to occur approximately 3 weeks before the end of term.

Please note as a general rule - no student will be enrolled under the age of 15 years.

Students over 18 years of age will be required to have a criminal history check. (This incurs an extra fee).

SERLC campuses do enrolment intakes each term. A student can pick up with their education journey where they left at their previous school.

All new students will have an interview with a campus leader which must be booked by appointment. This allows for a very personalised approach for each student and to explore what success means to them.

Please ensure you notify your previous school that you have left and are enrolling with us.

We may contact your previous school for background information to help us plan for your success. All students and parents/carers must complete the official enrolment form and sign the enrolment agreement – the enrolment agreement sets out the responsibilities of the student, parents/carers and the school staff about the education of students enrolled at one of our campuses that comes officially under Eagleby Learning Centre.

Please read through it with your child as there are several agreements regarding wearing of appropriate attire, behaviour and their willingness to step up and play their part in their success. All students are expected to be present, positive and productive. It is essential that a parent/carer attend the enrolment interview unless the enrolling student is over 18 or independent.

Please come prepared with the following information to the interview:

- Credit card/Eftpos/cash/bank transfer or Centre Pay will be required for payment of programs
- Transfer note if you are coming from another Queensland state secondary school
- Birth certificate, passport or Medicare Card
- Latest school reports
- Custody papers/family court/residency orders
- Proof of guardianship
- Proof of residence if unusual circumstance or independent student
- Proof of independence (Centrelink)
- Child in care documentation
- Proof of address/location (enrolment management plan)
- Any other information which may assist in your enrolment process e.g. health or family information.
